

Cuckmere Community Bus to visit Hailsham Farmers Market

Cuckmere Community Bus are offering people the opportunity to “Volunteer with a Difference” as they are visiting the Hailsham Farmers Market in Market Street on Saturday 9th August for potential volunteers to try driving one of their buses and to see for themselves what volunteering opportunities are available.

All of the people in their organisation, including drivers, are volunteers. They operate essential scheduled bus services for many communities in and around the Cuckmere Valley and beyond, linking communities with no other public transport, to the towns of Hailsham, Eastbourne, Seaford, Heathfield, Pevensey and Lewes and they also operate town services in Hailsham and Seaford.

Managing Director Philip Ayers says “As a very busy voluntary organisation we are always looking for more drivers to operate our services which run 363 days a year. We have teamed up with Hailsham Farmers Market who have kindly given us permission to use the large area at the back of the market so that people can see what it is like to drive one of our buses. We also have volunteers on hand to discuss the opportunities on offer and to show you what we do. Not only can you shop at the Farmers Market you can talk to us as well!”

“If you want to try driving one of our buses, please come along to the Farmers Market in Market Street Hailsham between 9 and 12am. You do not need a PCV license but you must have a category D1 licence, which was issued automatically to most people before 1997. Please note that we **MUST** see your valid licence before you can drive one of our buses at this event, so please bring it with you, otherwise we regret **NO VALID LICENSE - NO DRIVE**”
